

Scholarship FAQ's

1. Do I need to apply to receive scholarship funds?
 - a. Yes, Everyone must fill out the required paperwork to receive any scholarship funds
2. What type of programs can these funds be used for?
 - a. Scholarship Funds can be used for any LCRAC program or Independent Community League activity. Funds cannot be used for All-star teams, AAU, Travel Teams, Facility Rentals, Gym Memberships or daily use fees. Some other programs may not qualify for funds. If you have a question about which programs qualify, please contact us at 803-359-4048
3. Who can apply for scholarship funds?
 - a. Any Lexington County Resident may apply for these funds
4. Is my information kept confidential?
 - a. All information submitted to LCRAC is kept confidential.
5. Will leagues/instructors know I am using Scholarship Funds?
 - a. No one will know if you receive funds. LCRAC will maintain your confidentiality.
6. What if I do not have the required paperwork to receive scholarship funds?
 - a. Without the proper paperwork, scholarship funds will not be released to anyone. If you have a question about the proper paperwork, please contact us at 803-359-4048
7. How do I make my payments for programs?
 - a. Once you receive notification on your scholarship status, you will be able to pay your balance for your program to the appropriate organization.
8. How will I know if I will receive scholarship funds?
 - a. Anyone receiving scholarship funds will be notified through Email and by telephone.
9. How are scholarships awarded?
 - a. Scholarships are awarded on a first come, first sever basis. Once the Scholarship funds are exhausted, no scholarships will be award.
10. What happens if there is no money in the scholarship fund when I apply?
 - a. Your application will remain on file and active until we receive funds.
11. How long will my application remain active?
 - a. Your application will remain active for six months after you submit it for funds. Once an application is selected to receive scholarship funds, your application is removed from the active list.

12. What happens if my program starts before I receive my scholarship funds?
 - a. LCRAC will do our best to provide you with your Scholarship funds before your program begins, however we cannot guarantee you will receive your funds in time for your program. Please make sure you check the starting date for the program in which you are applying for and allow at least two weeks for the Scholarship process to be completed.

13. What happens if I decide to drop out of a program after I have receive Scholarship Funds?
 - a. If a recipient receives scholarship funds and then drops out of a program for non-medical reasons, they will be required to pay back the full amount of their scholarship award. The participant will not be allowed to participate in any program until they have paid back their scholarship funds.

14. What happens when I use my yearly allowance?
 - a. You will not be able to receive any more scholarship funds unless a hardship is approved by the Scholarship Committee.

15. Does the scholarship program help pay for any equipment or extra fees associated with programs?
 - a. No, the program will only cover the registration cost for a participant. All equipment and other fees must be paid for by the participant receiving the scholarship funds.

16. Where do the funds for the scholarship program come from?
 - a. Funds for the scholarship program are provided by Buffalo Wild Wings and their Eat Wings, Raise Funds program.
